

Names in Acts 6:5...

- I. Stephen:
 - a. McClintok & Strong(MS) - Στεφανος (Stephanos) = "A Crown"
 - b. Abarim Publications – Corona, "that which surrounds".
 - c. Friberg, Louw-Nida, Thayer, BDAG all – "that which surrounds"
- II. Philip – Φίλιππον(Philippon)
 - a. MS – "lover of horses"
 - b. Abarim – "lover of horses". Philos = "friend" or "beloved" + Hibbos = "horse"
 - c. Liddell & Scott, BDAG = "fond of horses" or "horse lover"
- III. Prochorus – Πρόχορον(PROCHORON)
 - a. MS – information but no relation of the name.
 - b. Abarim – "Choir Director". Pro = before or prior; CHORUS – "choir" or "director"
 - c. Thayer – "leader of the dance"
- IV. Nicanor – Νικάνορα(Nikanora):
 - a. MS - "Victor"
 - b. Abarim – "man of victory". NIKE(Victory) + ANER(man).
 - c. Strong – "victorious"
 - d. Thayer – "conqueror"
- V. Timon – Τίμωνα(TIMONA):
 - a. MS – says only "a common Greek name"
 - b. Abarim – "deeming worthy" or "honoring". TIO is "to value highly" or "honor"
 - c. Strong – "valuable"
- VI. Parnenas - Παρμενᾶν(PARMENAN)
 - a. MS – probably a contraction of παρμενίδης, "constant"
 - b. Abarim – "near stayer". They say from παραμενω (*parameno*), to stay with or by someone's side, from (1) παρα (*para*), near, and (2) μενω (*meno*), to remain.
 - c. NAS concordance – "constant"
 - d. Thayer, Strong – "steadfast"
- VII. Nicolaus(or Nicolas) – Νικόλαον(NIKOLAON)
 - a. MS – "Conqueror of the people"
 - b. Abarim – "victor over people". NIKE(Victory) + LAOS(common people).
 - c. Strong – "victorious over people"
